# Project 14C FULL 12-month live/work residency

Artists from all creative disciplines are welcome to apply to Project 14C's live/work residency program.

All applicants must be 21 years of age or older at the start of the program period.

This Project 14C's residency program is 12-months in duration. Artists may apply for a solo live/work studio space **OR** they may apply for a shared space of up to 4 artists.

**All artists applying for a shared space must fill out individual applications. We will not match you with other artists, you must have a pair or group of artists set before you apply. Artists sharing space do not need to be in the same artistic disciplines.**

We generally consider applications 2-3 months in advance.

Our panel evaluates applications on the first week of each month, with interviews scheduled as appropriate. Applications submitted during July will be evaluated in the first week of August.



Answers on THIS page must be completed in one session - after you have saved the answers on this tab, your application will be saved and can be completed - and then edited or amended as needed until the deadline.

After completing this page, click on "save" and move on to the "Criteria" tab, then through the "Attachments" tab you must upload a minimum of 1 image, with a maximum of 10.

Once your entry is complete you will be directed to submit and pay the application fee, *this is a necessary step, even if there is no fee associated with an application.*

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## Community and Living

Being part of a creative community is integral to Project 14C. More than 150 artists will be residents of three floors of living and working space.

Project 14C has large studio spaces with room for both live and work, which range in size from 877sq ft (81.5 sq m) to 1,507 sq ft (140 sq m).

Each has two bathrooms and a kitchenette. Beds, desks, chests of drawers and armoires are also provided, as well as dining tables and chairs.
